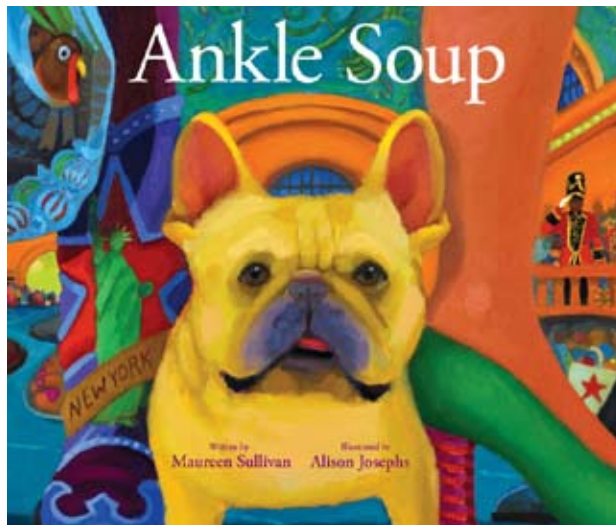

*Ankle Soup* was first concocted on a real Thanksgiving morning in Grand Central Terminal, and is destined to become a family classic for children everywhere at Thanksgiving celebrations to come.
